For over 15 years, Amy has worked across the world to implement initiatives that make lasting positive change.

Director, Disaster Services, Vibrant Emotional Health, New York, NY — 2017-Present

- Leads the Disaster Services department at Vibrant Emotional Health, a \$2.5M program that serves over 5,000 people annually through disaster behavioral health.
- Leads the program vision and development of a disaster behavioral health response cadre of 1000+ providers and subject matter experts across the United States.
- Developed and launched the concept of the Crisis Emotional Care Team and its corresponding programming, securing nearly \$2M in funding for its operation.
- Trains organization, government and healthcare workers in team leadership during crisis and change.
- In September 2023, designed and implemented a wellness event for over 1500 healthcare workers in New York City.
- In 2021, facilitated the deployment of close to 100 volunteers across the United States as a part of Operation Allies Welcome.

This event now engages over 150 agencies in best practice disaster mental health training.

- Coordinated the training of over 100 volunteers during the pandemic to respond to crisis calls through NYC Well/988.
- Authored numerous articles and trainings to support the advocacy and visibility of disaster behavioral health in leadership, refugee care and disaster response.
