Clinically Significant: calculated using the instrument's Reliable Change Index (RCI) and cutoff score, which together define standards for clinically significant change achieved during mental health treatment. The RCI is the amount by which a client's total score must increase (deterioration) or decrease (improvement) from intake to be considered clinically significant. Changes in the total score that are less then the RCI are not statistically relevant (i.e. no change). Outcomes are not calculated until there has been reliable change within a given instrument.

Outcomes; Improved, Stable, Recovered, and Deteriorated are calculated by episode.
